



Dear Parents,

With the Easter Holidays fast approaching it seems a good point in the school year to give parents an update on Mathletics and some of its new features, designed to help you keep up to date with your child's progress.

Mathletics is a useful tool to support the development of your child's maths confidence. As teachers it's useful for assessments and for giving opportunities for your child to consolidate their understanding of maths concepts covered in class. For you as parents it means that you can allow your children safe use of a tablet or laptop with a highly educational outcome. Each time your child uses Mathletics they earn points.

Points are awarded to students as they successfully complete Live Mathletics and Curriculum Content within Mathletics. Students gain points for each correct answer. The more correct answers – the more points! Students receive the most points through completing Curriculum Content with each correct answer equating to 10 points. The points contribute to earning of certificates and a place in the 'Hall of Fame'. Certificates are granted when a student earns 1000 points or more within one week. This encourages students to complete a healthy amount of work each week and rewards students for every week they practice. Students initially earn a bronze certificate, then once five bronze have been gained, a silver certificate is awarded. After four silver certificates a student then receives the much-coveted gold certificate, demonstrating their long-term commitment and developing ability. Points reset for the week at 7pm on a Sunday.

Certificates are usually presented in our Friday assembly and we also award a trophy to the class that has accessed Mathletics the most during the week.

Credits - Credits are earned by participating in Live Mathletics and the Curriculum Content. These credits allow students to purchase items for their online avatar. This is a fun and engaging way for students to personalise their experience, encouraging a greater investment in their efforts and results.
