## **Year 5/6 Trip to Crucial Crew Wednesday 25<sup>th</sup> April 2018**

The Rotary Club of Sudbury have organised an event called the Crucial Crew, aimed at teaching children in years 5 & 6 about safety. Below is an extract from the Crucial Crew Ipswich website with further explanation:

The aim of Crucial Crew is to provide a fun and stimulating environment for children to learn to:

- become more aware of personal safety;
- learn how to react correctly to dangerous and threatening situations;
- understand the role the emergency support services play and how and when to contact them;
- be aware of their own actions and the safety of others.

Every child visits scenarios where they are taught valuable safety messages. The scenarios are run by a diverse range of highly skilled people such as the Fire and Police services, UK Power Networks, Life Saving Club, St John Ambulance and Suffolk County Council Road Safety Team with the support of volunteers.

The sessions tackle issues of personal safety such as Waterside safety; First Aid; Road safety; Electrical safety; Fire safety; Alcohol awareness; Personal safety; Internet safety and Railway safety.

The trip will take place:

**Wednesday 25<sup>th</sup> April, leaving school at 12.00pm, returning to school at about 4:15pm.**

The event takes place at AFC Sudbury, Brunton Lane, Sudbury and we will travel there by coach paid for by the school.

Your child will need to bring in a packed lunch on this day, as lunch will be taken early before we leave for the event. If your child receives free school meals and you would like a packed lunch provided on this day, please indicate on the reply slip attached.

**Note: Some scenarios will take place outside so children should bring a coat. Please can girls bring trousers to change into for the event.**
