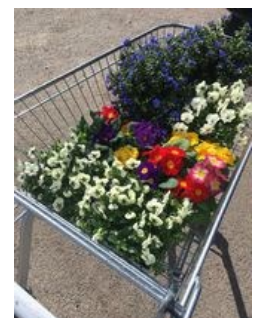


Emailing the school
