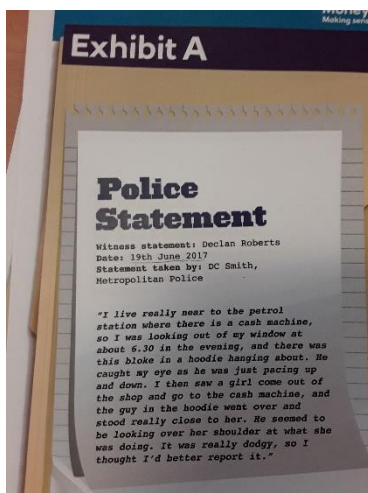
History Day
