

KS1 Medium Term Plan Autumn Term 1 2023 – Fire! Fire!











English

We will start the term looking at the book **Naughty Bus**, a fantastic picture book that follows the journey of a badly behaved London bus. We will then enhance our History knowledge by reading **The Great Fire of London** as a class. The children will finish the term by reading **A walk in London**. Within these texts they will explore writing for many purposes including: posters, captions, diary entries and story maps.

Maths

EYFS KS1 children will be begin the year practicing their **Place Value** skills. Y1 children will focus on numbers to 10 to really solidify their knowledge, whilst Y2 children will extend their learning to numbers up to 100. Both year groups will practice counting backwards and forwards, representing numbers in different ways, subitizing and writing numbers in numerals and words. We will also be using our rekenreks during **Mastering Number** sessions.

Science

We will be looking at **Everyday Materials.** Saplings will be investigating a range of different materials and discovering their properties. Alongside this they will be looking at using the same material for different purposes as well as why sometimes the same object is made from different materials.

Phonics

Children will learn to read and write words containing the phase 5 graphemes. Children will have access to the school library each week and will bring home both a new 'reading for pleasure' and a Little Wandle decodable book on a Friday.

ΡΕ

Saplings will be taking part in whole class (Nursery, Reception and KS1 children) PE sessions on a Thursday and Friday afternoon. This term we will be focusing on introducing PE to our youngest children.

ART/DT

This term we will be designing and constructing our own moving windmills.

Geography/History

We will be learning about the **Great Fire** of London. The children will learn about how the fire started, how quickly it spread and why it took so long to put out. We will also learn about how the fire service has changed and improved over time. The children's History learning will be complemented during English lessons this term.

RE

Our focus question in RE this term will be: Why is the word 'God' so important to Christians? We will explore

PHSE

This term we will be focusing on Families and Friendships in PHSE sessions.
