

EYFS Medium Term Plan Autumn Term 2 2022 – Transport













Personal, Social and Emotional Development

This term we will be focusing on **Safe Relationships** during the PHSE sessions that EYFS children will attend alongside KS1 children. Adults in school will continue to encourage and support Nursery and Reception children to talk about their feelings and develop appropriate ways of being assertive. We will also encourage children in Reception to think about the perspectives of others as they continue to learn about expected behaviours in school.

Physical Development

Children in EYFS will be encouraged to use a range of smaller tools, such as paintbrushes and scissors, effectively when creating in school. They will have opportunities to work with their peers to manoeuvre larger construction equipment, working on developing their overall body strength and coordination. EYFS children will also take part in two formal PE sessions a week, alongside KS1 children. Nursery children will be encouraged and rewarded for changing independently for these sessions.

Communication and Language

error children will be listening to longer stories and encouraged to join in with stories that they know well. They will have opportunities to retell well known stories using a variety of resources including puppets and small world characters. Children will learn a range of new vocabulary through joining in with class discussions and they will be encouraged to explore this further in their play. Reception children will be encouraged to ask and answer questions.

Literacy

All EYFS children will continue to bring home a reading for pleasure book this term, and Reception children will also bring home a phonetically decodable book that they will be able to read to an adult. In school children will focus on correct letter formation for the sounds that they are learning in phonics, and they will be encouraged to represent these when writing independently.

Maths

This term children will be learning to count to, represent, compare, and compose the numbers 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5. We will explore circles, triangles, and rectangles before moving on to thinking about night and day, time, and measuring.

Children will be encouraged to explore the ideas introduced through adult led Maths sessions in their play.

Understanding the World and RE

Our focus question in RE this term will be Why do people give gifts at Christmas?

EYFS children will continue to work and play outside, exploring the natural world through hands on experiences. They will be encouraged to extend their own thinking through asking questions and making comments about what they have observed. All children will be encouraged to notice and talk about the changing of the seasons as we move through Autumn into Winter.

Expressive Arts and Design

EYFS children will be encouraged to talk about different materials and explore what can be done with them. They will join different materials, exploring their textures and talking about how this makes them suitable for different purposes. We will also be learning and performing new songs together as we prepare for our Nativity performance!

Phonics

We will continue to move through Phase 2, learning the new single sounds j, v, w, y, x and z as well as the digraphs qu, ch, sh, th, ng and nk. Children will also learn to blend words ending with s and some new tricky words. We will continue to change both school books on a Friday this term.
