

Key Stage 2 results 2017

Raw percentages can sometimes be a little misleading as in a small school the cohort may be as small as 6 children, meaning each child is a large percentage in statistical term.

There were 10 children in the 2017 cohort. Each child is therefore worth 10%

30% of the cohort (3/10) had SEN

Mobility in this cohort was high. All pupils who started at our school met the expected standard.
