History Morning

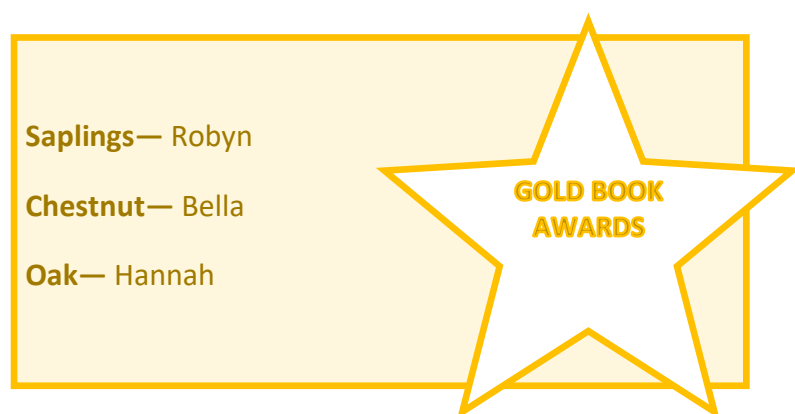
